Charging & Remissions Policy

PURPOSE OF THE POLICY

To provide clear guidelines on Charging and Remissions matters for parents/carers, pupils, staff and other stakeholders.

Introduction

All the education we provide during normal school hours is at no charge to pupils. We do not charge for any activity undertaken as part of the National Curriculum.

When organising school trips or visits to enrich the curriculum and the educational experience of the children, the school invites parents and carers to contribute to the cost. All contributions are voluntary. If we do not receive sufficient voluntary contributions, we may cancel a trip. If a trip goes ahead, it may include children whose parents or carers have not paid any contribution. We do not treat these children differently from any others.

If a parent wishes their child to take part in a school trip or event, but is unwilling or unable to make a voluntary contribution, we do allow the child to participate fully in the trip or activity. Sometimes the school pays additional costs in order to support the visit. Parents and carers have a right to know how each trip is funded and the school provides this information on request.

The following is a list of activities, organised by the school, which require voluntary contributions from parents and carers. These activities are known as 'optional extras'. This list is not exhaustive:

- Visits to museums etc;
- Musical events or Sporting activities which require transport expenses;
- Outdoor adventure activities;
- Visits to or by a theatre company;
- School residential visits;
- Swimming.

Residential visits

If the school organises a residential visit in school time, or mainly in school time, which is to provide education directly related to the National Curriculum, we do not make any charge for the education. However, we do suggest a charge to cover the costs of board and lodging. If we cannot raise sufficient funding through these voluntary contributions, the visit may have to be cancelled, and that aspect of the curriculum would have to be covered in other ways.

Music tuition

All children study music as part of the normal school curriculum, We do not charge for this.

There is a charge for individual or small-group tuition, since this is an additional curriculum activity and not part of the National Curriculum. These individual or small-group lessons are taught by peripatetic music teachers who have their own charging policy and Tolleshunt D'Arcy St Nicholas CofE (VA) Primary simply collects money on their behalf.

After School Activities

The School offers additional activities after school. Since some of the coaches are not members of the school staff and run and organise the sessions, they sometimes make a charge for these sessions.

Monitoring and review

This policy is monitored by the governing body and will be reviewed every two years, or earlier if necessary.
