

APPEALS TIMETABLE FOR CHILDREN STARTING INFANT, JUNIOR OR
PRIMARY SCHOOL FROM SEPTEMBER 2021

16th April 2021	National Offer Day- parents are informed of the outcome of application by Essex County Council. <i>(Places are offered to all applicants in accordance with the schools Admission Policy. (Please see above policy and school catchment area map.)</i>
17 May 2021	<p>Deadline for submitting appeals <i>(INFANT CLASS SIZES APPEALS: This applies to yrR, 1 and 2 classes where classes are limited to 30 children. If you're appealing an infant size class limit, your chance of a successful appeal is limited.</i></p> <p><i>An appeal can only succeed if:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <i>1. Admitting an extra child would not breach the class size limit.</i> <i>2. Your child would have been offered a place if the admission arrangements had complied with the admissions law or were correctly and impartially applied.</i> <i>3. The admission authority's decision to refuse a place was not one which a reasonable admission authority would have made in the circumstances of the case.</i> <p><i>(Deadline for submission of additional evidence by all parties, and for clerk to send appeal papers will be confirmed by ECC Appeals Clerk on acknowledgment of appeal.)</i></p>
7th June to 19th July 2021	Appeals heard for those submitted by the deadline and where possible, for late appeals (last day of term: 16th July 2021) <i>(Those that make an appeal will received at least 10 school days' notice of their appeal hearing.)(Decision letters are sent by Essex County Council within 5 days of the hearing wherever possible.)</i>
September 2021 onwards	Appeals heard for any appeals not heard before 16th July 2021

If your child is not offered a place at your preferred school, you can lodge an appeal to Essex County Council against the decision.
