Do you know how long your pets or favourite animals live for? Find out, what about similar animals, make a chart. Extension: How about the life span of some birds, you'll be surprised.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Design and Technology</u></p> <p>Focus: Measuring the height of a tree with your thumb. You really can! Look at your most recent piece of written work and how many of your year group expectations you have used. What have you missed out and can you re-write your work to include more of them. Complete the sequences challenge. Lots of the questions are similar to ones that you have all been solving so well in the Maths Mysteries. In 1995 the BBC asked the public to name their 100 top poems and published them as The Nation's Favourite Poems. Search for the book and you will find a list of all 100, have a look with family for ones that you have heard of and new ones, have a read.
