Class 4 Creative Homework Spring 1 Due in on Wednesday 10th February 2021

There are 6 weeks in this half term and so you must complete a minimum of 6 Creative Homework tasks, as usual you are free to do more if you like. All homework must have accurate spelling and punctuation, handwriting must be as good as the best example you have in your handwriting book. Any artwork has to be well thought out and shows that you have made a proper effort to produce it.



Our topic this half term is the Tempest by William Shakespeare and this homework follows a theme of the sea, ships and boats, islands and the weather.

- 1 using papier mache or similar make the hull of a boat.
- 2 draw and label a yacht, remember that all of the sails, beams and the rigging have their own names.
- 3 we have islands on the coast of Essex, research one of them and write a report.
- 4 make a note of the wind speed twice a week and finish the task by plotting the results on a graph. You could tell me the average over the half term.
- 5 from our classroom we can see the River Blackwater Estuary. What wildlife of all kinds (birds, bugs, animals, plants, fungi...) can you see there and are they different from the wildlife that you find at the beach? Tell me why.
- 6 write a report about the life of William Shakespeare. Where was he born, what did his family do, where did he go to school, how many plays and poems did he write? You could illustrate this.
- 7 how much of the world was known to the people of William Shakespeare's time? Use maps and writing to explain.
- 8 how many islands make up Great Britain? What are the largest, the smallest, do people live on all of them?
